A Rocha Kenya

A Rocha Kenya is a Christian environmental charity whose work includes: -

Marine conservation and research in Watamu Marine National Park in the Western Indian Ocean. Monitoring coral reef decline and the loss of fish species. Measuring microplastics and organising beach clean-ups for plastic pollution.

Environmental education in schools, communities, churches and youth wildlife clubs. Resourcing teachers to teach about the environment.

Giving bursaries, funded by eco-tourism, to secondary school pupils to promote conservation of local forest eco-systems which are important but threatened areas of biodiversity.

Helping the Kenya Bird Map project to map all of Kenya's bird species and to describe their risk status. Citizen Scientists help to capture the data and upload to the website.

Teaching conservation agriculture to improve yields and reduce deforestation in a scheme called 'Farming God's Way.

We will include A Rocha Kenya in our prayers at Christ Church services. Please remember them in your private prayers too. There'll be regular updates on specific prayer requests posted on the board in the prayer corner in church.
